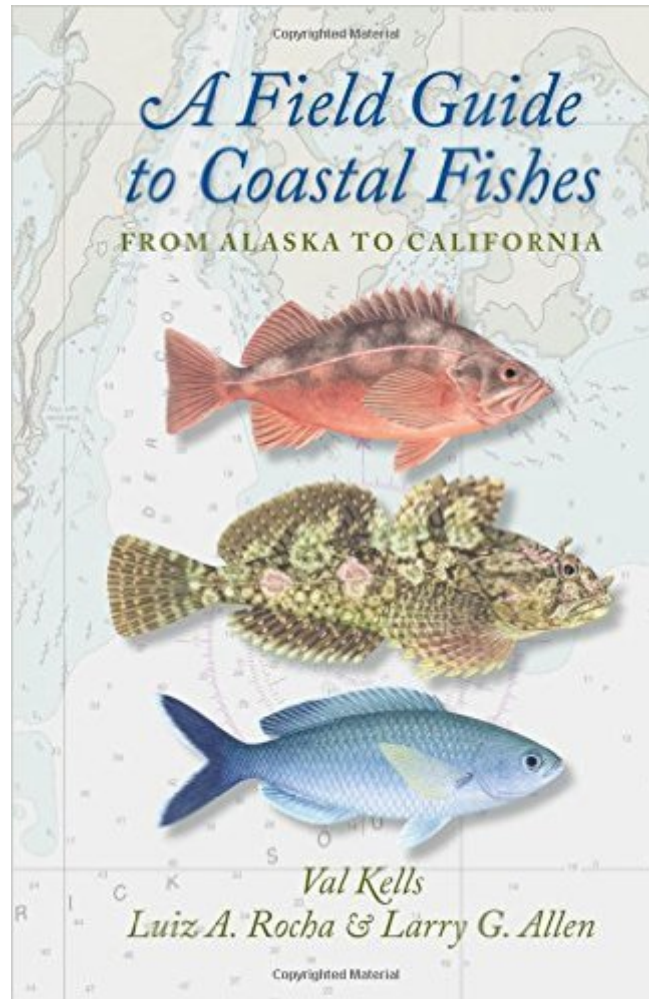

Also this book does not include a systematic key to identification for the generas - a problem shared by many other amateur field guides. But to be honest, many species are hard to tell apart, and having a key to identification is crucial in the field, and would certainly bring this book to a totally different level.
