

I purchased this as a textbook, but after reading it cover-to-cover I would absolutely recommend it for the layperson with a curiousity about architecture. It explains in not-too-much detail the basic concepts of architecture, without overwhelming the reader with technical jargon (and for the little jargon that is included, there is a nice glossary in the back).
