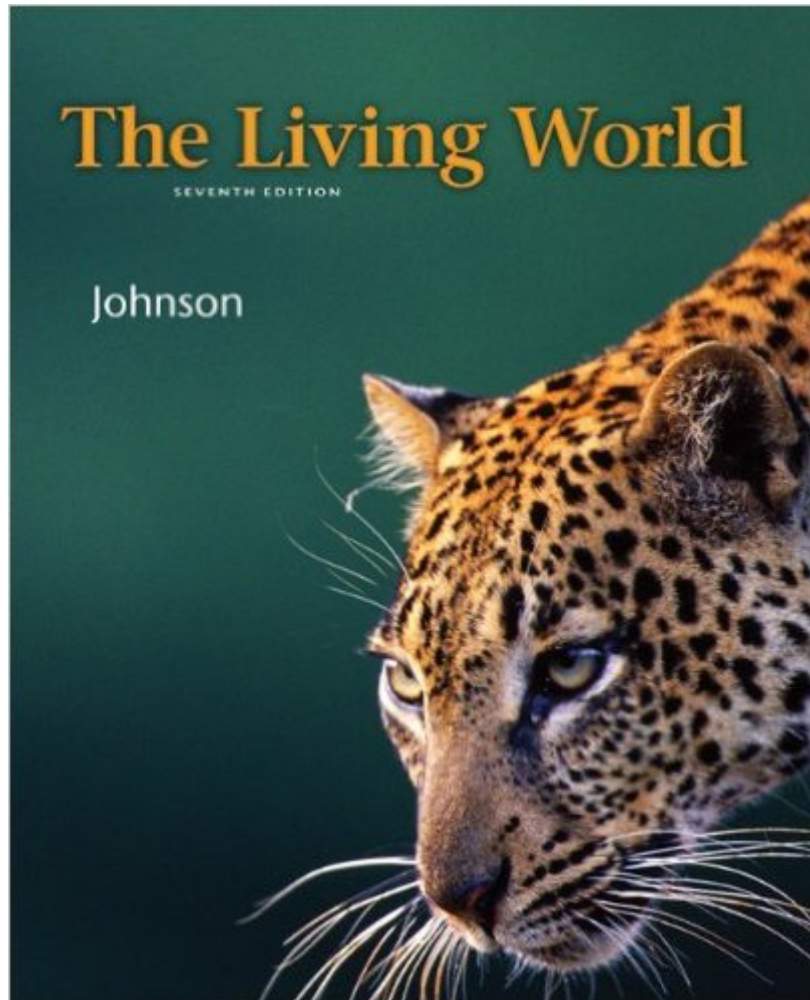

The chapters were a little mixed around and there was 1one added chapter that we didn't even use. So I was golden. The book is interesting and informative, if you can read it!. The text in some sections are incredibly small. I had to buy a magnifier just to read the questions and some various other sections. some of the smallest print I've ever encountered in a textbook. I'm very disappointed.

Initially, I tried to purchase this book through 's "tgrogan", but this didn't work. She offered a used text for \$10. It was a week before she saw the email regarding my interest in purchasing it.
