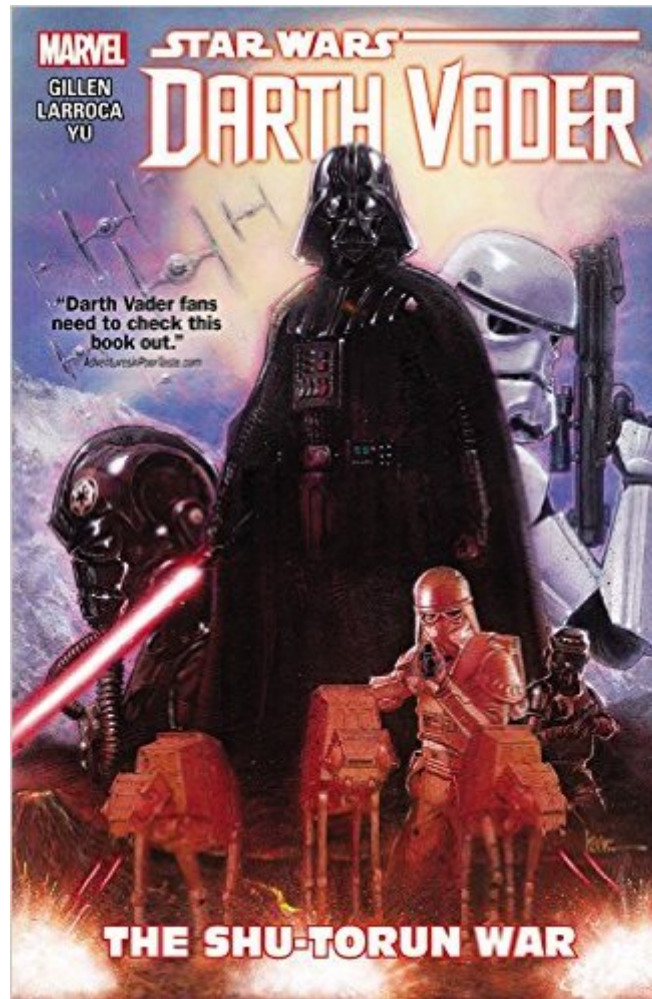

3.5 stars. The art is good - the splash pages are quite good. This series focuses on Darth Vader and his conflicts with other forces within the Empire. Reading (and observing) stories where he crushes his opposition is fun and the kind of dominant fights that fans of Empire Strikes Back have been hankering for decades. The story loses a little with the intrigue within the Empire, particularly where different Generals, Admirals and advisors plot against him. This is not a young Vader that is being challenged post Episode three, but a height-of-his powers Vader 20 years into the job. The idea that the Emperor finds this acceptable doesn't jibe well with that kind of long-term working relationship (even for Sith lords, who are always wary of each other). That critique aside, it's a fun read and Star Wars fans will be pleased.

Fantastic continuation of the amazing Darth Vader Series, showing Vader going to war with the

planet of Shu-Torun on behalf of the Empire, and shows what he is doing to deal with the abduction of a major Vader comic character that occurred during Vader Down.

The Darth Vader series of comic books never fails to entertain and enlighten readers with an interesting anti hero protagonist and a compelling cast of characters that have become Star Wars icons in their own right. Such as the murder bots triple zero and Beetee thier antics are always entertaining and sadistic.
