

The three full length books are really one 1,000 page novel. It is, of course, very important the they be read in sequence. It would be very hard to imagine that anyone could read the first one (Outrage) and not complete the next two. A completely new cast of Sanford characters are delightful in many ways, and he has plenty of time to fully develop them with that many pages. Great chance to
